February Minutes

S & B Quilt Guild Meeting, Feb. 8, 2020, Memorial Hall, Hotchkiss, CO 81419 The Meeting was called to order at 9 a.m. by President, Cally Gallegos. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all. Guests Vicki VanKleve and Diane Walker were introduced or and welcomed. Cally opened the meeting with the request that if there are Guild concerns, please bring them to her initially so she can decide how to proceed. The minutes as written in the Newsletter were approved with the correction of Terra Hegy's name and spelling. Correspondence: A thank you from the Hotchkiss Chamber of Commerce for our recent membership, a letter and cards from the Rocky Mountain Quilt Museum introducing the new Exhibit "The Boys are Back in Town", a thank you note from Pete Tarr for his Caring Quilt and the very nice thank you note from the recent winner of the 2019 Raffle Quilt - Patty Baker, 870 Jenny Lane, Berthoud, CO 80513. Treasure's Report: Rita Sussman, acting Treasurer, gave the report. Regular Account: Beginning Balance - \$2,633.86, Disbursements - \$431.19, Receipts - \$1,375.00, Ending Balance - \$3,577.67 Raffle Account: Beginning Balance - \$4,986.98, Disbursements - \$136.90, Receipts - \$17.00, Ending Balance - \$4,867.08. Committee Reports: Refreshments sign-up was passed around for coming meetings. Programs: Kay Dennison showed some quilts that were made and were introduced as an upcoming class. She said the materials would have to be cut and ready for the class. Patterns are \$10 and the rulers are \$13 to \$18. The class is suggested for April 10. The pattern is a Sara Silver Quilt Design called "Unbeweaveable". The Hunters Star class by Judy Clay has sent cutting instructions and supplies. Wanda Gofforth has lots new Caring Quilt fabrics. Lida had a pattern for a 10" block and some different bindings. Lida also has the handout for the 1/2 square triangles 8 at a time. Cally also asked that any Caring Quilts that are made be displayed at our meeting. Margaret Osborn handed out 24 brown bags for the Challenge Quilts. It is required to use everything that is in the bag but one can use other fabrics and mainly have fun. The Raffle Quilt for 2021 has 9 blocks, is a wool wall hanging and the blocks have been handed out to the 9 volunteers for this project. The Ugly Fabric by Bev Shiflet requested everyone get busy on their projects. She also said she has lots and lots of fresh eggs for anyone who wants some at \$3 per dozen. Block of the Month: Tammy Marty said that the first part will be displayed in March for those members that are creating this quilt. Call Tammy or LaVern if you have questions. Sunshine Person: Della Collins said she sent cards to MaryK Eversman for the loss of her sister in law and also Ann Perry for a recent surgery. Works in Progress: Keep working on them with Connie Barry on vacation. Raffle License: License is in place and the raffle tickets will be available March 14. Fair: Trish Tuin is on vacation but will have a meeting later in the month . The 2020 Raffle Quilt was presented by Diana Ballinger. Trish will be helping Ivy Rezak with the issuing and tracking of the Raffle tickets to the members. The Guild still needs a volunteer for scheduling the venues for the Raffle Quilt ticket sales. Lida Letey reported on the Luncheon and Trunk Show offered in Cedaredge May 9 for \$20. Lida can be contacted to get information if members want to attend. Sew and Share had several members show new completed projects. Refreshments were enjoyed and then several members stayed to sew on Caring and Vet Quilts for sharing with those needing them.
