S & B Meeting, August 8th, 2020

**Works in Progress:** Sue Caven asked that we look at the email about WHIPS. She will make a new folder of the projects.

**Fair:** Trish announced that Shari Davis and Kathy Carlson will be the new Fair coordinators for next year. Changes to book are finished but the book was not printed. Cally encouraged members to continue to sew because we have a Quilt Show next year, too.

**Raffle Quilt:** No report on the raffle quilt for next year.

**Tickets and Venues:** Ivy said we have 45 envelopes checked out, and 16 were sold. \$325 was given to Sally today. Dianna said she had brought 2 packets of tickets from LadyBugz. Ivy suggested we bring the quilt back for Saturday Farmers' Markets in Hotchkiss. She and Dianna will coordinate that. Dianna will take it to Basket Case next month for their meeting. Rita has visited with the State about using the raffle money. They understand we can't use our monies this year. They just don't want us to stockpile the money.

**Name tags:** Alice has name tags. Cally would like us to start wearing them. With a twinkle in her eye, she said we might regret that we haven't worn them at the end of the year.

Dianna is going to Salt Lake for batting if anyone wants to order before she goes. She will go within the next two weeks. Wanda wants one roll for Vet and Caring quilts.

Karla announced that the Mystery Quilt is on step 2.

Five members showed beautifully finished projects for Sew and Share.

A question was asked about the class monies that haven't happened or are not happening. Rita said we should direct questions to Lida Lety. Trish brought up that since we're having a show next year, we need to begin thinking about chairwomen.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:50.


