We appreciated the input from quilters as to how much was needed to make quilting the quilts easier, we tried to take your suggestions so hopefully we did it ok. Kathy Steckel asked us if we would be able to make some coverup like gowns for the ambulance folks. She is going to purchase the fabric and Ann Perry is putting a pattern together for us so when we get the fabric we can put the kits together. She asked if we could make 10 and I suggested that she purchase a poly blend of fabric for these gowns so they didn't have to be ironed before use.

Our next vet/caring quilt day will be September 21 at the Hotchkiss ambulance office and we will plan to meet at 10. We hope to have some blocks that the guild members have made for vet quilts so we can try to get some of those put together. Please members keep working on Vet quilts for next year. We have no plans to have a November brunch this year but we need to work toward having a lot of quilts for next year. I don't have a count of how many quilts yet but there are not many at this time. Dianna has agreed to quilt vet quilts for us again this year. Thank you Dianna and to all who have been able to help.


