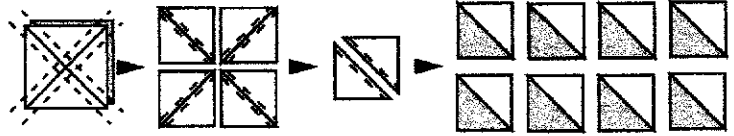





HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE CHART ✂




SQUARE UP! Cuts are large to allow for squaring up. This improves accuracy. You'll be glad for the wiggle room later!

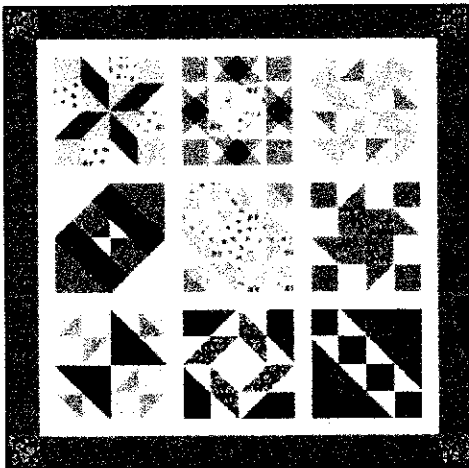

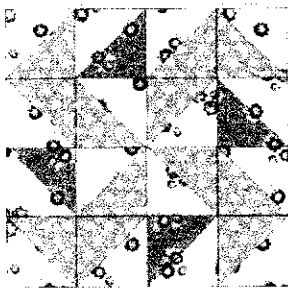

Block #9 - Yankee Puzzle



Yankee Puzzle Quilt Block

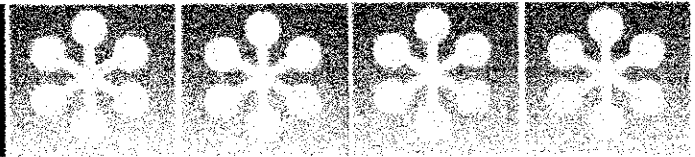
Fabric Color	Cuts
Tiny Rose Blue	Cut TWO (2) 4 1/2" squares. These will be paired with the Tiny Rose Cream/Red 4 1/2" squares to create FOUR (4) half-square triangles.
Dots Green	Cut SIX (6) 4 1/2" squares. These will be paired with the remaining Tiny Rose Cream/Red 4 1/2" squares to create TWELVE (12) half-square triangles.
Tiny Rose Cream/Red	Cut EIGHT (8) 4 1/2" squares. On the back side of each square draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner, ONE (1) time. TWO (2) of these will be paired with the Tiny Rose Blue 4 1/2" squares to create FOUR (4) half-square triangles. The remaining SIX (6) will be paired with the Dots Green 4 1/2" squares to create TWELVE (12) half-square triangles.

Handwritten notes: 2/8, 1/8, 1/8, 1/8

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) and see if you get the correct block size.

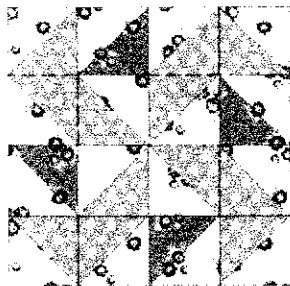

Yankee Puzzle Quilt Block

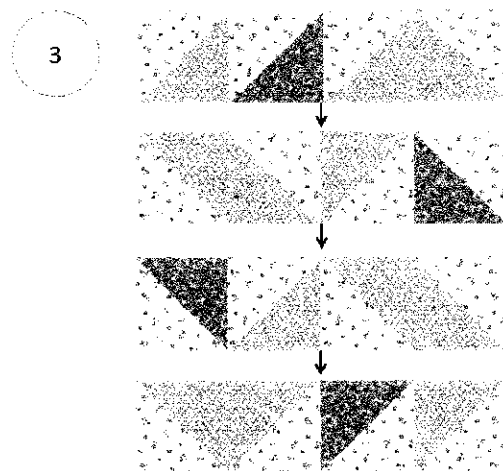
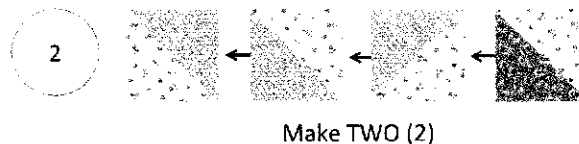
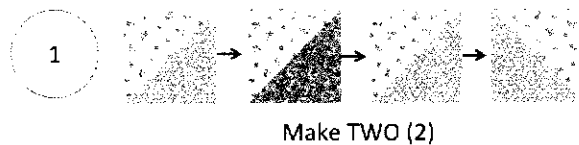


Quilt Note: When making half-square triangles, try cutting your squares $1/4"$ or $1/2"$ larger than the pattern calls for, then trim them down to the exact size needed for your quilt block.

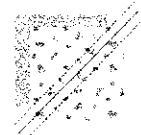
In the case of the "Yankee Puzzle Quilt Block," you need to trim the half-square triangles down so they are $4"$ square.

This pattern has been tested, to the best of our ability. If your block does not come out the size shown, please try adjusting your needle position to the appropriate position (left or right) and see if you get the correct block size.

Press in the direction of the arrows.



Half-Square Triangle Tutorial



Place the Tiny Rose Cream/Red $4\ 1/2"$ square on the Dot Green $4\ 1/2"$ square (right sides together) and sew $1/4"$ on EACH SIDE of the line you drew. Then cut the half-square triangles apart ON the line you drew.

You will end up with TWO (2) half-square triangles.

Press toward the darkest fabric. Clip your corners (aka dog ears).

Repeat this technique for remaining half-square triangles, paying attention to the fabric colors, for this quilt block.
