## Standard Bed and Batting Sizes

Bed size	Mattress size (width x length)	Batting size (width x length)
Crib	27" x 52"	45" x 60"
Twin	39" x 75"	72" x 90"
Double (or Full)	54" x 75"	81" x 96"
Queen	60" x 80"	90" x 108"
King	76" x 80"	120" x 120"

## Sample Quilt Sizes

Drops are on three sides	Twin (39 x 75) (w x l)	Double (54 x 75) (w x l)	Queen (60 x 80) (w x l)	King (76 x 80) (w x l)
w/ 10" drop + 10" tuck	59 x 85 59 x 95	74 x 85 74 x 95	80 x 90 80 x 100	96 x 90 96 x 100
w/ 12" drop + 10" tuck	63 x 87 63 x 97	78 x 87 78 x 97	84 x 92 84 x 102	100 x 92 100 x 102

"Drop" is the part of the quilt that hangs over the edge of the mattress.

"Tuck" is the part of the quilt that folds under the pillow.
