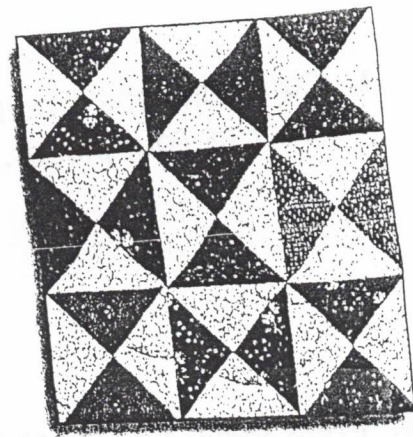

Fabric Amounts:

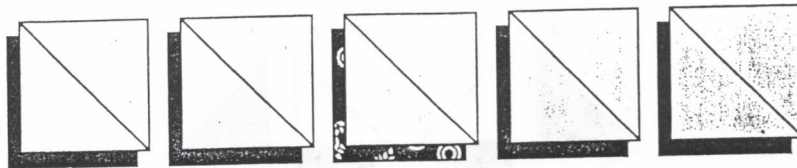
Background Fabric 6 1/2" x 30"  
Five Different Colored Fabrics 6 1/2" square

Cutting Instructions:

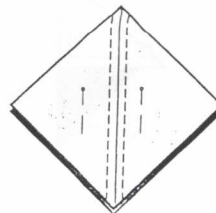
Background Fabric  
Cut 5 - 5 1/2" squares  
Colored Fabrics  
Cut 1 - 5 1/2" square from each fabric

Making the Bow Tie

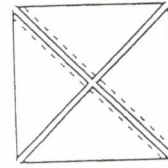
1. Pair the five prints and the five backgrounds, right sides together.  
Draw a diagonal line on each background square.



2. Sew 1/4" on each side of the line.

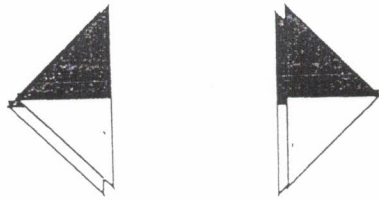


3. Cut each square on both diagonals  
Creating four pieces.

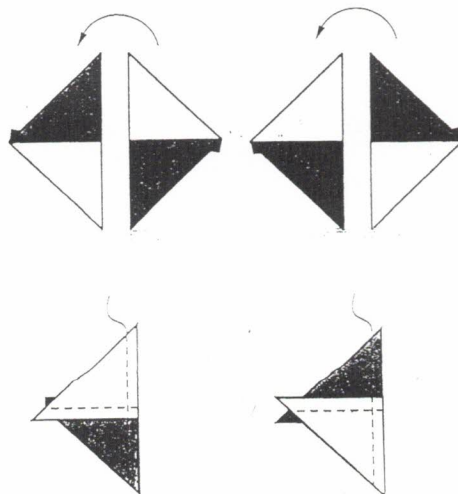


4. Press seams toward the dark fabric.

5. Make two stacks with dark fabrics at the top as shown below,  
pairing like colors.

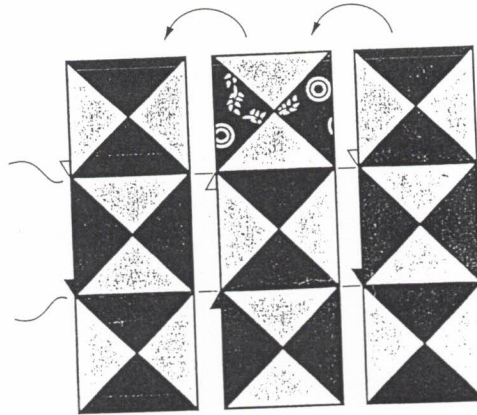
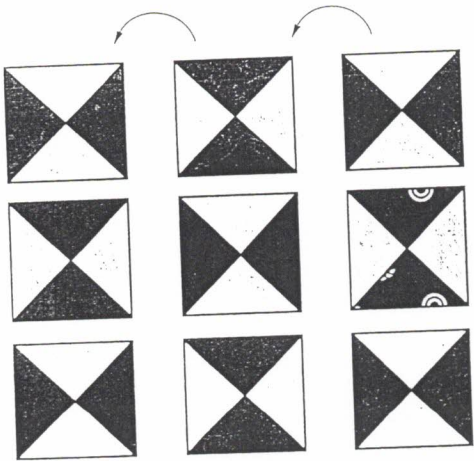


6. Working with one stack at a time, lift the first two matching triangles off the stack and turn the top one 90 degrees. Sew this pair together with locking seams. Continue thru both stacks until you have ten pieces.



7. Set seams. Do not press open if you are using the Quilt in a Day Triangle Square up Ruler. Otherwise, press open and square each block to  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".

8. Lay out patches in three rows. Stitch in vertical or horizontal rows, then stitch the three rows together.
