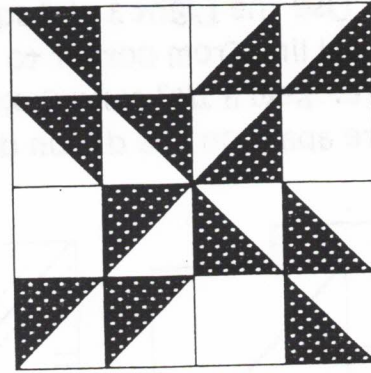

12 1/2" unfinished (12" finished)

Fabric Amounts:

Light Fabric 4 1/2" x wof
 Dark Fabric 4 1/2" x 30"



Cut (See fabric layout to the right):

Fabric is folded in 1/2:
 (Except when cutting only one)

Light Fabric

From the 4 1/2" strip cut

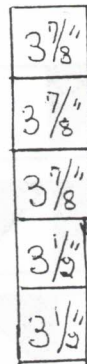
- 6 - 3 7/8" squares
- 4 - 3 1/2" squares

Dark Fabric

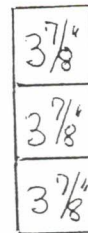
From the 4 1/2" strip cut

- 6 - 3 7/8" squares

LIGHT



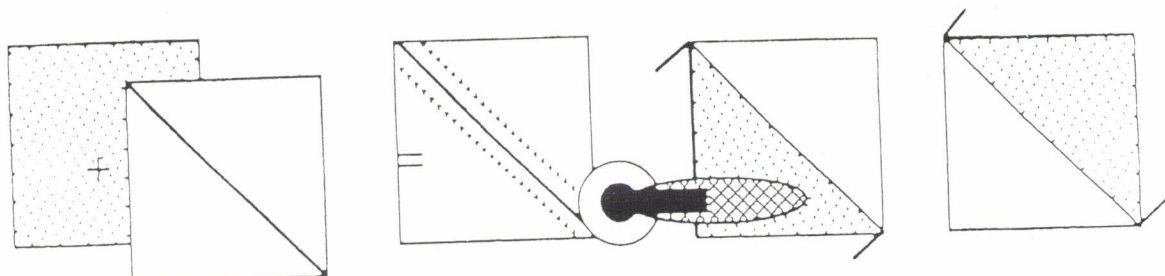
DARK



TIP: Organize your cutting. Take a few minutes to write all the cut sizes on sticky notes. Then, cut the largest pieces first, working in descending order, through each fabric.

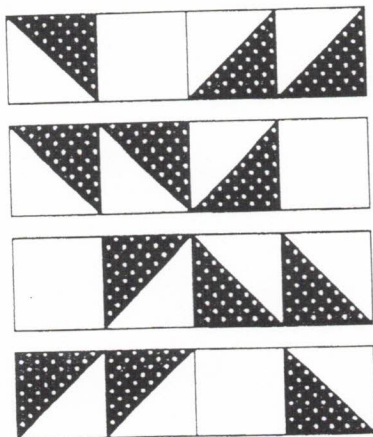
Half Square Triangles

Use the Light $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and the Dark $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner, on the back side of the light square. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of the drawn line. Cut the square apart on the drawn diagonal line. Trim off the "dog ears".



Make twelve (12).

Assemble as shown:
