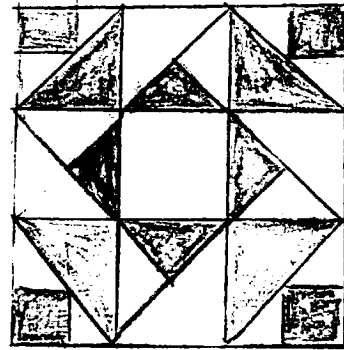
Aunt Dinah

12 1/2" unfinished (12" finished)

Fabric Amounts:

Light Fabric 6" x 28"

Dark Fabric 6" x 28"



Cut (See fabric layout to the right):

Light Fabric

From the 6" strip cut

- 5"
- 2 - 4 7/8" squares
 - 4 - 3 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles
 - 1 - 5 1/4" square
 - 1 - 4 1/2" squares

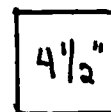
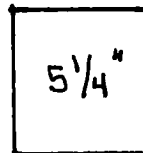
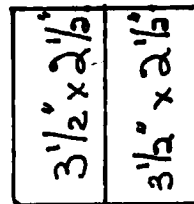
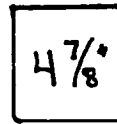
Dark Fabric

From the 6" strip cut

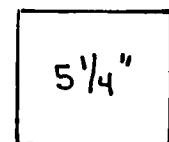
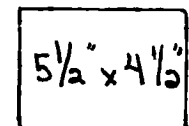
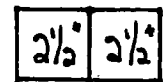
- 4 - 2 1/2" squares
- 2 - 5 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
- 1 - 5 1/4" square

Fabric is folded in 1/2:
(Except when cutting only one)

LIGHT

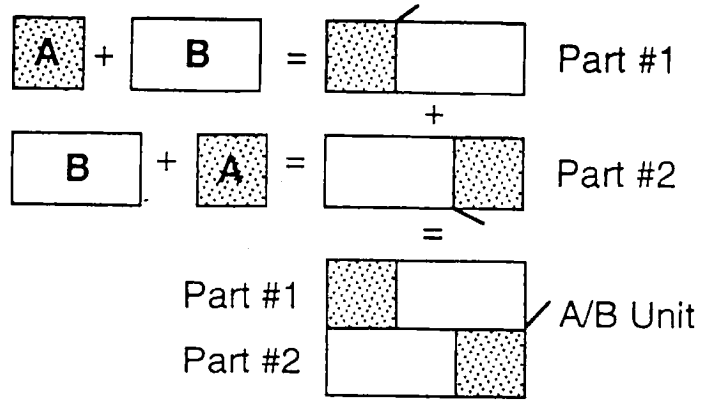


DARK



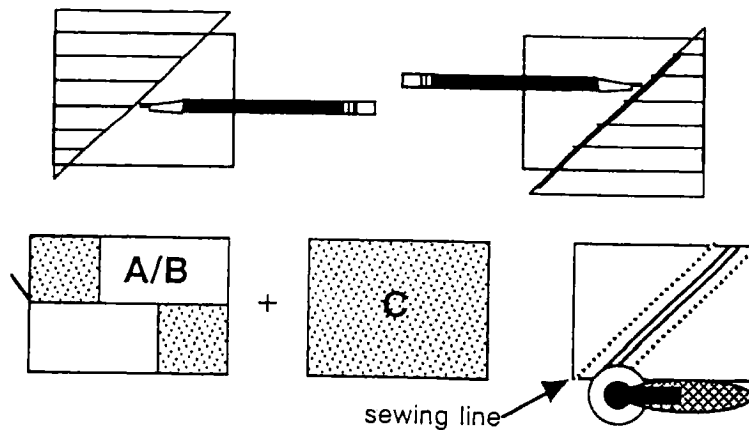
Shaded Four Patch Unit

Using the four Light $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles and four Dark $2\frac{1}{2}''$ squares, follow the diagrams to construct the A/B unit. Press as shown.

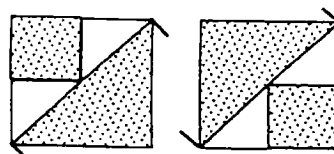


On the wrong side of C (which is your dark $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle), draw a diagonal line from top right corner, at a 45 degree from the $4\frac{1}{2}''$ side of the rectangle. Draw another line parallel to the first line from the opposite corner, also at a 45 degree angle.

Place C on top of the A/B unit and stitch on the lines you have drawn. Cut $\frac{1}{4}''$ from stitching as shown in diagram below.

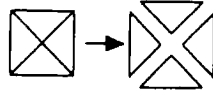


This process makes 2 Shaded Four Patch Units. Repeat this process once. You need 4 of the units shown below.

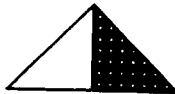


Shaded Double Triangle

1. Cut the light and dark $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares into quarters diagonally.

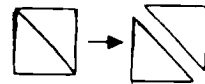


2. Sew a dark and a light triangle together as shown.

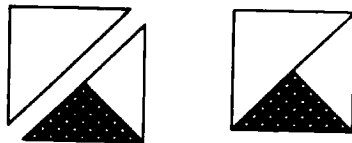


Make 4

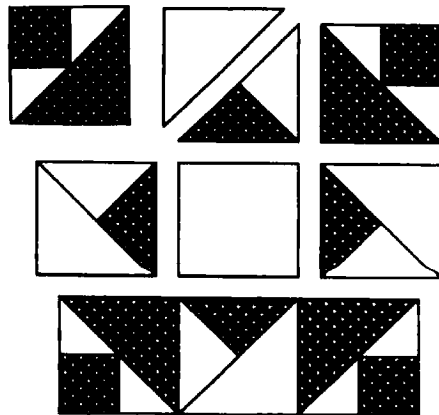
3. Cut the two (2) light $4 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares in half diagonally.



4. Sew the four (4) light half square triangles from step three (3) to the four light and dark half square triangles made in step two (2). Make four (4).



Assemble block as shown below.
