

Block of the Month.
(from Virginia H.)
Easy Bow Tie

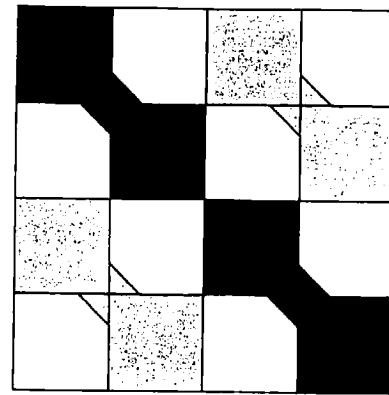
12-1/2" unfinished

Fabric amounts:

Darks #1 and #2 4" x 12" piece of each

Mediums #1 and #2 4" x 12" piece of each

Light 4" x 30"



Cutting instructions:

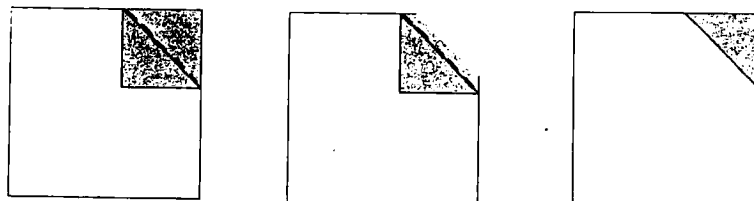
From each of the dark and medium fabrics-cut (2) 3-1/2" squares and (2) 2" squares

Light-cut (8) 3-1/2" squares

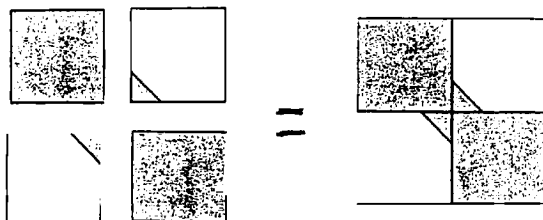
Sewing instructions: sew all seams with a scant 1/4" seam

For each Bow Tie unit you will need the 3-1/2" and the 2" squares of the color and (2) 3-1/2" squares of the light.

1. Draw a line on the back of the 2" color squares on the diagonal. Place in the corner of a 3-1/2" light square with right sides together. Sew on the line. Trim as shown in the diagram. Press to the color. Make 2 of these.



2. Sew these units to the 3-1/2" color squares to make a Bow Tie unit.



3. Make 4 of this and stitch them together to complete the block.
