

S&B Take and Make
Saturday, April 8, 2023
Cloth Rope Bowl

MATERIALS:

Sewing Machine with manual (the machine needs to be able to zigzag)

Acrylic table for your machine is helpful to keep the bowl flat as you're sewing.

Applique or zigzag foot (a foot with a center mark is helpful).

Machine Needles #80 or #90 or Jean.

Thread (this is a fun time to use up miscellaneous threads, they can match or contrast). It is easier to see your stitches with contrasting thread.

Normal sewing items (tape measure, scissors, hand sewing needles, straight pens, clips, stiletto)

Portable light if your machine doesn't have a good bright light.

11 yards of 3/16" poly reinforced cotton clothesline. (the pattern calls for 11 yards but I'd suggest doing 12 yards in case you want to make the bowl slightly bigger you can decide when you reach the 11 yard point).

½ yard of 100% cotton fabric or scrapes

1/8 yard of fabric for binding (optional)

Acid free fabric glue stick.

Painter tape.

\$5.00 to cover room rental.

PREWORK:

- Cut ¾ inch wide strips of cotton fabric.
- Wrap your clothesline cord (see attached directions) prior to coming to the class. The directions suggest wrapping a foot at a time but it is much easier if you wrap your entire length before the class. Roll the rope loosely into a ball or accordion to keep it under control as you sew.
- Clean and oil your machine prior to the class. This can be a very linty project.
- Fill 3 or 4 bobbins, yes, I went thru 3 ½ easily.
